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MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN COMMUNITY SURVEY RESULTS SUMMARY

The Village of Barnwell has initiated the preparation of its first Municipal Development Plan (MDP). Pursuant to section 632 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, an MDP is a statutory planning document that is adopted as a bylaw by the municipality and is one of the tools a community can use to manage growth and future development.

The Municipal Development Plan will outline the goals and objectives that a municipality has for future development and creates policies that will aid in achieving them. An important component in the MDP preparation process is soliciting public input from the citizens of the municipality.

As a method of determining citizens' concerns and opinions, the Village of Barnwell chose to deliver individual questionnaires to each household during the month of May, 2012. The questionnaires were returned to the Village of Barnwell by June 15, 2012. The questionnaire was designed to provide Village Council information concerning the direction Barnwell should pursue in the future.

A total of 220 questionnaires were circulated throughout the community and 55 surveys were completed and returned to the Village office. This represents a 25 percent response rate. This document is a summary of the results of the completed questionnaires received by the Oldman River Regional Services Commission. The questionnaires were analyzed and a statistical breakdown with commonalities and recurring themes are summarized below.

Highlights from the Questionnaire

- Approximately 63 percent of the respondents were female and 33 percent were male.
- Approximately 28.3 percent of respondents were from the 30-39 age group.
- Approximately 35.3 percent of respondents have lived in Barnwell for five years or less.
- Major Likes:
 - Small/quiet/safe town
 - o Town size and atmosphere
 - o Town pride
- Major Dislikes:
 - Road quality and volume
 - Village rules and bylaws regarding local pets and yard maintenance
 - Lack of local businesses and youth activities

1. What do you like most about Barnwell or do not want to see changed?

After reviewing the responses, the citizens of Barnwell have determined the following characteristics to be the most notable aspects of their community:

- That not all the streets are paved or fixed. I also think Barnwell should become stricter with messy yards.
- Roads are crap. (high taxes for little to no services)
- Cats are all over the place. (cat bylaw?)
- More opportunities for youth employment.
- Maybe be a little more energetic when plowing and sanding in the winter.
- The logo?/identity phrase.
- Get rid of curbside recycling. Limit number of cats.
- Dogs that drop feces on my lawn.
- That Barnwellians will not support the businesses here. It is just easier to go elsewhere than to help those establishments.
- People being able to ride their horses through the village and not cleaning up after them.
- We need a good convenience store/gas station and maybe a reliable restaurant. (of some sort)
- Too many stray dogs running around. 6 Ave and _ street is in very poor condition. Snow removal of streets in winter. Kids doing stunting on streets.
- I think we have a big problem with cats. Our neighborhood has about 20 some cats. So we always have them in the yard, pooping everywhere. If you live in town, it's too many cats per household.
- I don't think there is anything that needs to be changed.

 residential community. Accesses to other services are already close, i.e. Taber and
 Lethbridge. Taber already struggles to maintain the facilities, businesses, services, etc., they
 have without compensation from Barnwell. Plus, Barnwell isn't large enough to support
 more facilities and services.

- We need to put up speed limit signs in the newer residential areas. This is because vehicles and home builders are going way too fast, especially in areas where our children are playing.
- I think it would be awesome for Barnwell to have a spray park for kids. I know many mothers have talked about it and it would be well used in the summer months. There isn't a lot to do in Barnwell for recreation and this would add nicely to the community. You can recycle the water and even build it next to the existing park. I know as a mother this would be a major bonus to living in Barnwell.:)
- Let's not grow too big. We like the small town feel and we want to raise our children in this environment. Don't take that away from Barnwell.
- Focus on making our schools and recreational facilities superior than other facilities in neighboring communities. This would draw more people into our community, which would in turn encourage more businesses to move to our community.
- We really need a police presence on evenings and weekends. Local kids are taking yard decorations and driving way too fast on our streets. 6 Ave is the worst. Dogs are also a big

problem. What's with the train whistle blowing late at night? Is there not a rule somewhere about that?

- Administration is doing a good job.
- This is a good community!!! Let's keep it small and laid back!!!
- Pass a bylaw limiting the number of cats.
- I believe Barnwell should remain a residential bedroom community of Taber with limited services. In order to keep taxes as low as possible. Also, I think growth should be limited so as to limit the need of costly upgrades to existing services. Smaller lots would help reduce the cost of lots and services and the cost of property taxes.
- Would you accept short editorials for your monthly letter, where people can give suggestions for the enhancement of the village?
- Can you ban garbage burning? Please enforce that dogs should be on a leash! Is there a bylaw to regulate loud vehicles? If not, we should have one.
